SECTION 1.0: INTRODUCTION

POLICES, PROGRAMMES AND PROJECTS FROM 2015 – 2023

With a previous successful Law practice and a public service career of over two decades, in the course of which he served as Chief of Staff and Commissioner in the Lagos State Government as well as two term Governor, Mr. Babatunde Raji Fashola, SAN is now serving a second term as Minister of the Federal Government having first been appointed in 2015 and reappointed in 2019.

2015 - 2019

The Federal Ministry of Power, Works and Housing is a creation of the 2015 Ministerial Reform. The Ministry is responsible for initiation and implementation of national policies on power, roads, housing, lands, urban development and related sectoral issues.

The core mandates of the Ministry are:

- I. Generation, distribution and transmission of power nationwide.
- II. Planning and design of highways, construction and rehabilitation of highways; monitoring and maintenance of federal roads & bridges nationwide; survey and mapping of the nation's internal and international boundaries
- III. Habitat and provision of affordable housing for Nigerians.

Throughout the period under review (May 29, 2015 – March, 2019) the focus of the Ministry has been on the following key areas:

- I. Progressive increment of supply of power nationwide;
- II. Provision and maintenance of federal roads and intervention in other roads that are critical to economic and social development;
- III. Management of national policies on housing, public buildings, and lands and urban development.

SECTION 2.0: BACK TO THE INFRASTRUCTURE BEAT

2019 – 2023

Upon his reappointment in 2019 to the Ministry of Works and Housing, Mr Fashola SAN has the responsibility of taking forward the progressive mandate of executing the most radical, audacious and arguably the biggest infrastructural expansion ever experienced in Nigeria.

This includes the revival of long-neglected capital projects, inherited from previous administrations and several new mega projects that were initiated and are at various stages of completion. Among these are:

- I. The Second Niger Bridge, linking two very economically important states, Anambra and Delta, and connecting the East and Western zones of Nigeria which hitherto had seemed like a mirage.
- II. The Lagos-Ibadan Expressway, though originally completed in 1978, a population boom and a lack of commensurate expansion meant that the road was no longer able to accommodate its growing users. The rehabilitation, reconstruction and expansion of this critical project has now been given the priority it demands after years of unhelpful stalemate.
- III. The Bodo-Bonny Bridge, a major flagship project in Rivers State, had been conceived since 1970s but several attempts to initiate construction, tottered until 2015 and further progressed from 2019 with over 7,000 direct and indirect jobs already gone into ensuring a handover of the bridge and ancillary roads by 2023.
- IV. The Abuja-Kaduna-Zaria-Kano Road is made up of 3 sections namely Abuja-Kaduna (completed in 1996), Kaduna-Zaria (completed in 1991) and Zaria – Kano (completed in 1991). Over the years only minor repairs were carried out until reconstruction work commenced in 2018 with funding sustained through one of the initiatives of the Buhari administration – the Presidential Infrastructure Development Fund (PIDF).

SECTION 2.0: BACK TO THE INFRASTRUCTURE BEAT

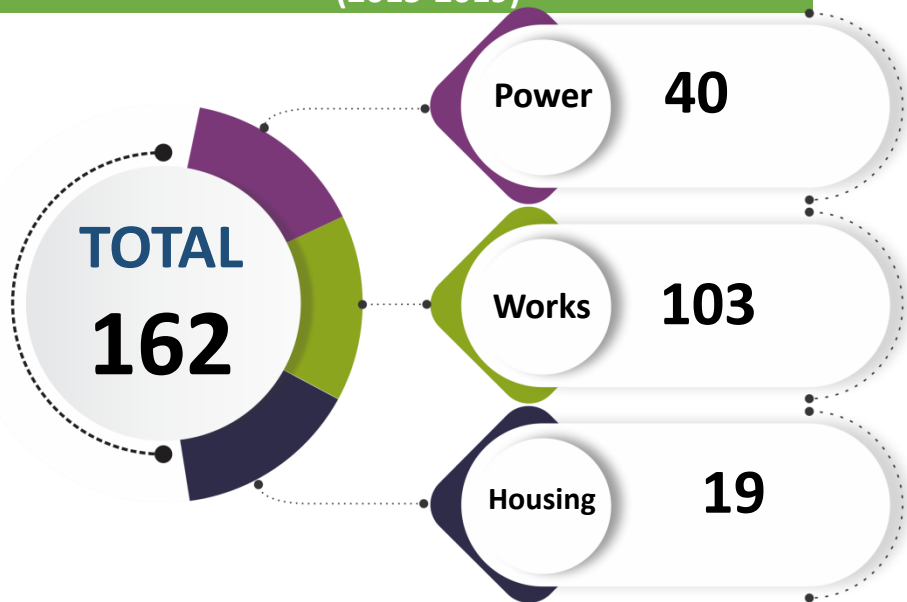
Indeed, with the many other projects being undertaken by the Ministry of Works and Housing under the leadership of Mr Babatunde Raji Fashola SAN comprising over 1,706 contracts in 1,649 projects aggregating to over 13,000 Km of Roads and Bridge infrastructure as well as other Housing Sector activities, the progressive legacies of the President Muhammadu Buhari led administration is becoming real in infrastructure development and human capital development.

Consequently, with the approach of the final leg of the administration a number of projects are being completed, nearing completion are being commissioned in different parts of the country. It is indeed a season of completion, commissioning and impact.

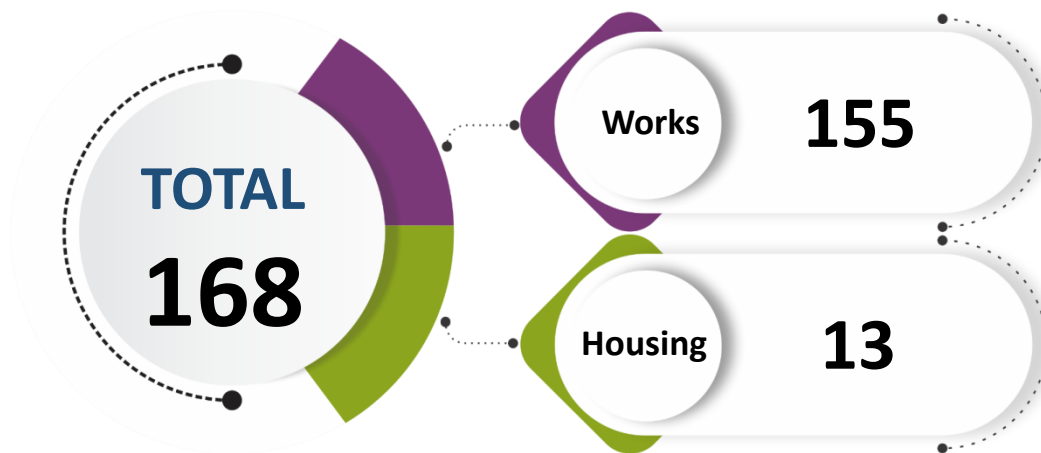

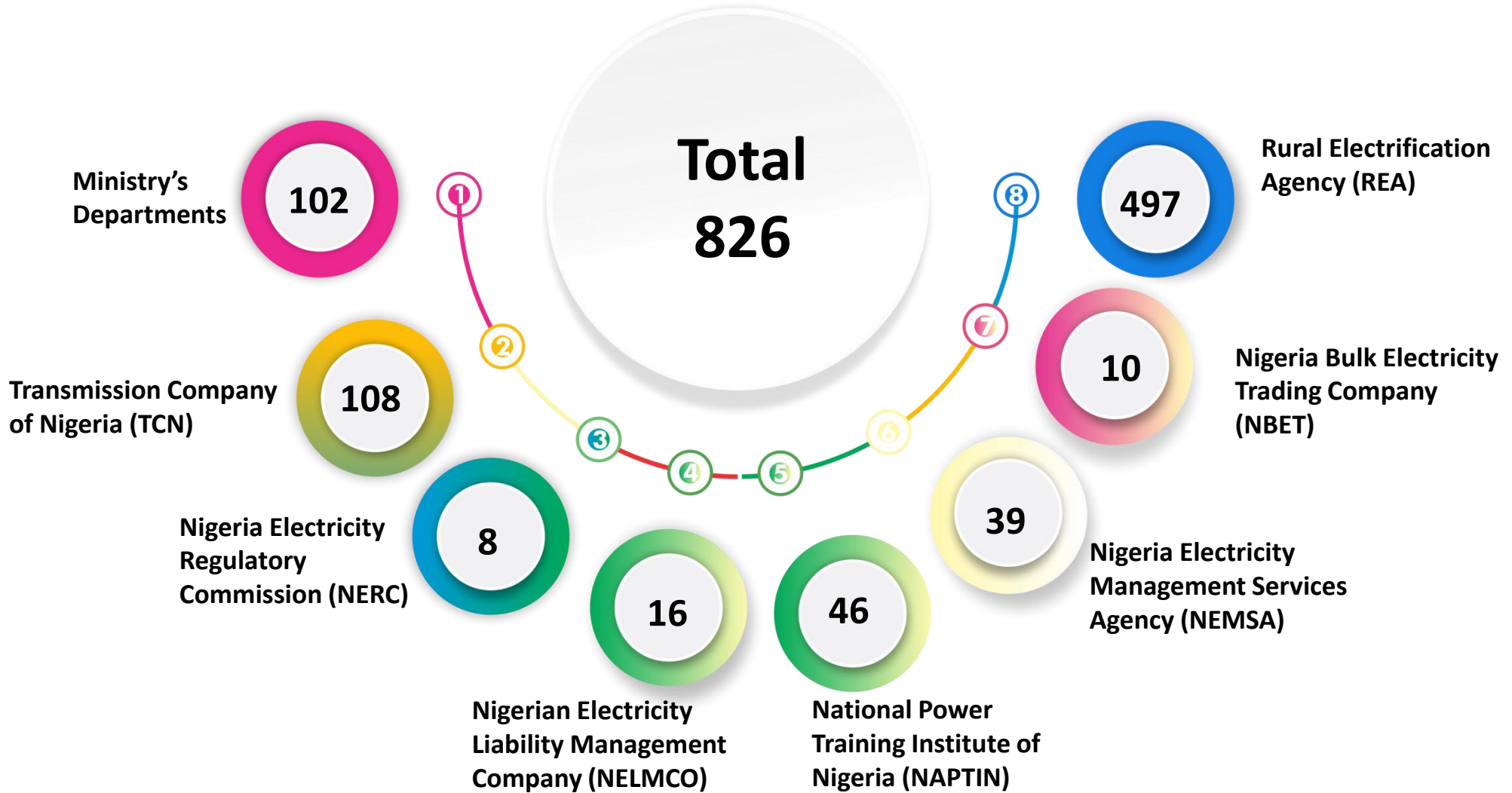

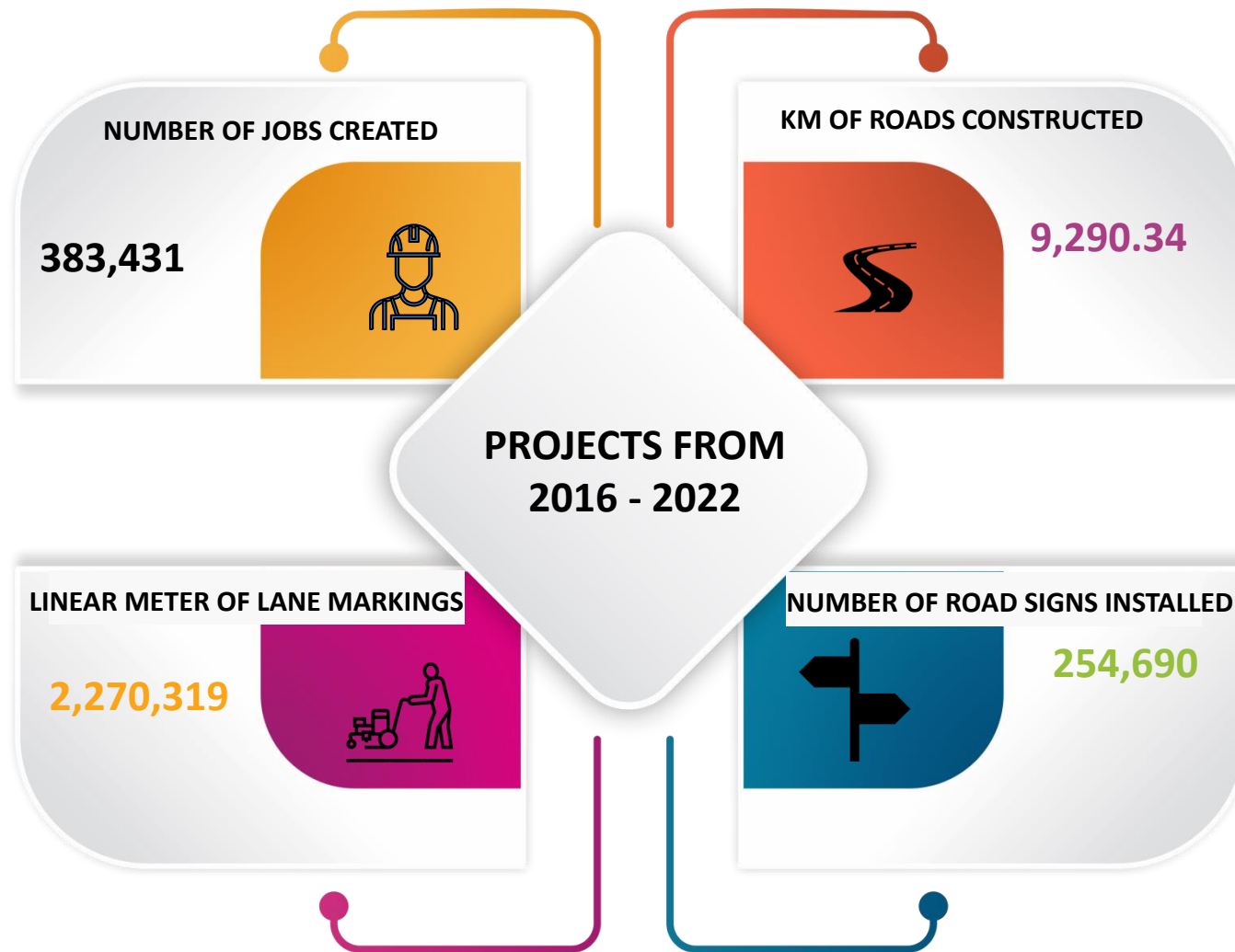

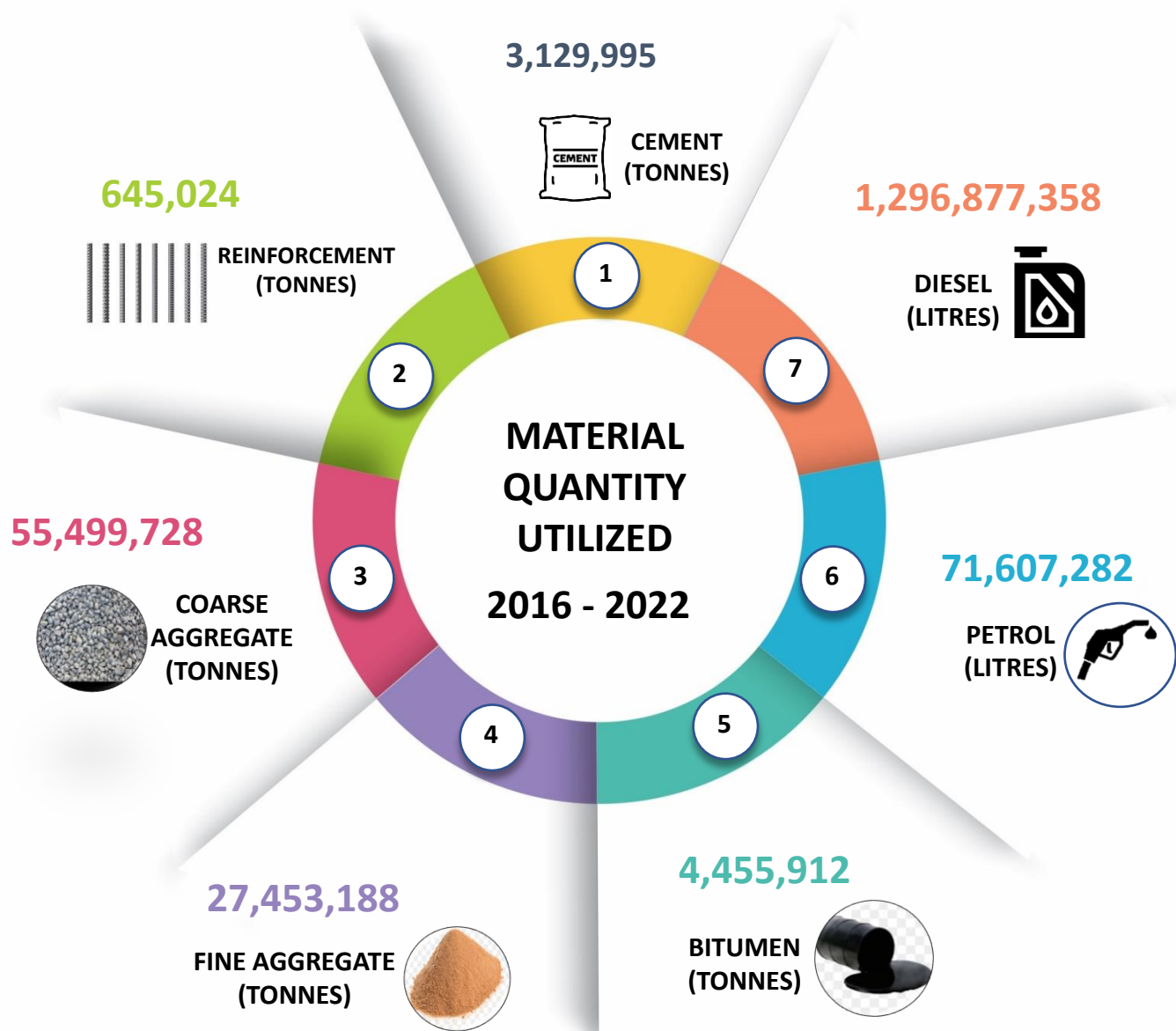

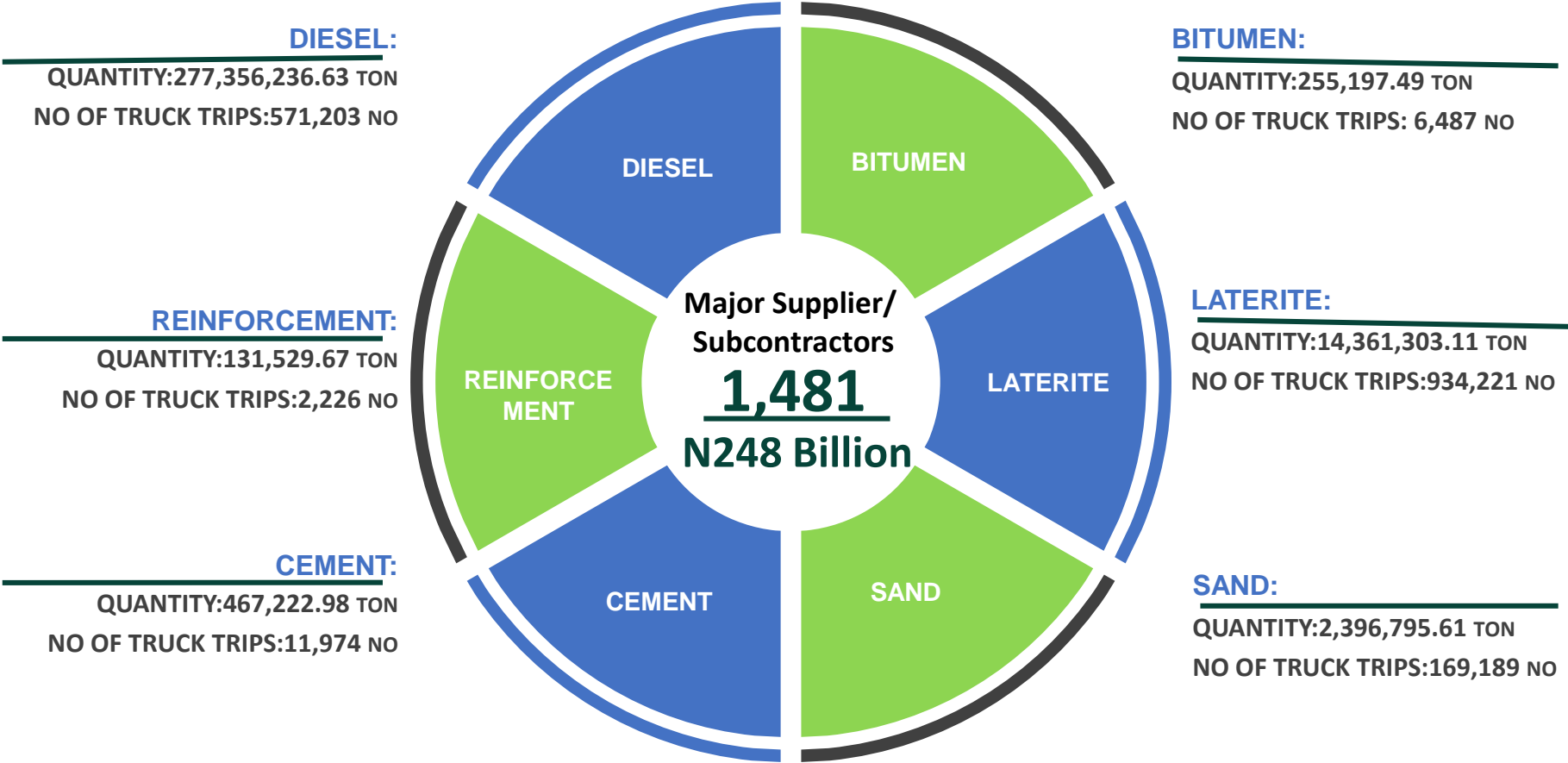

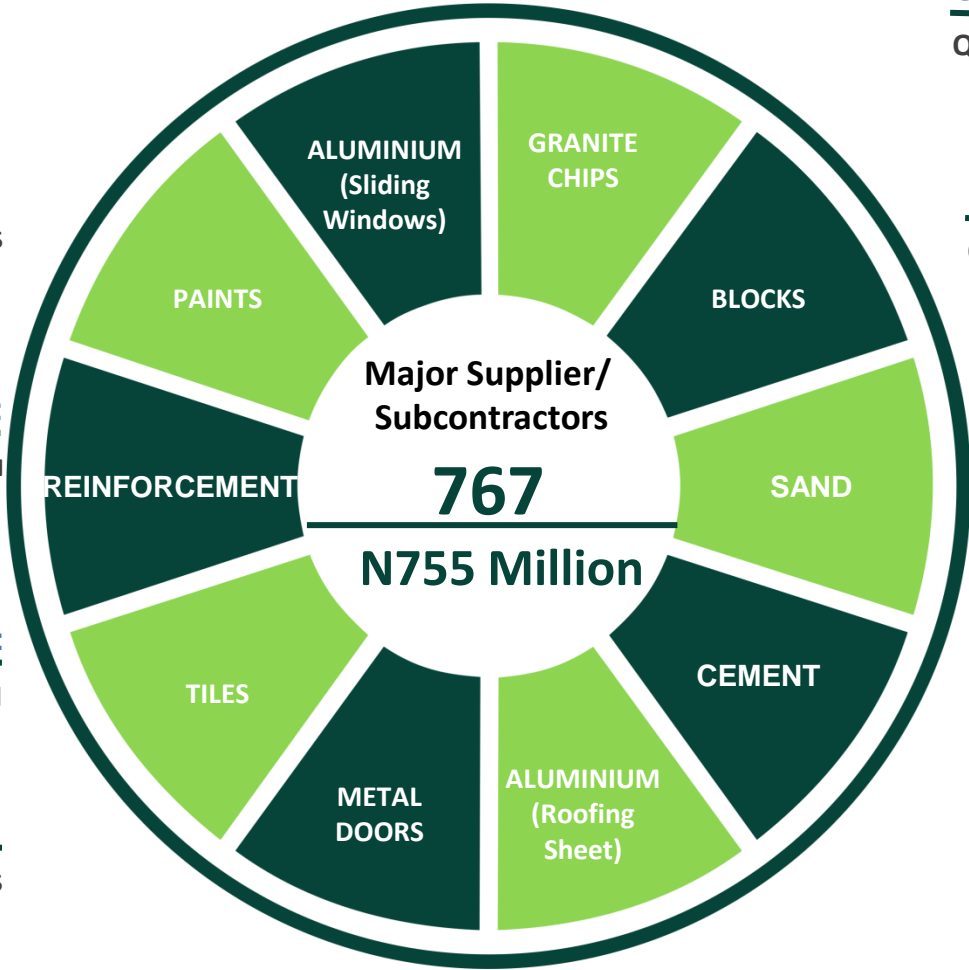

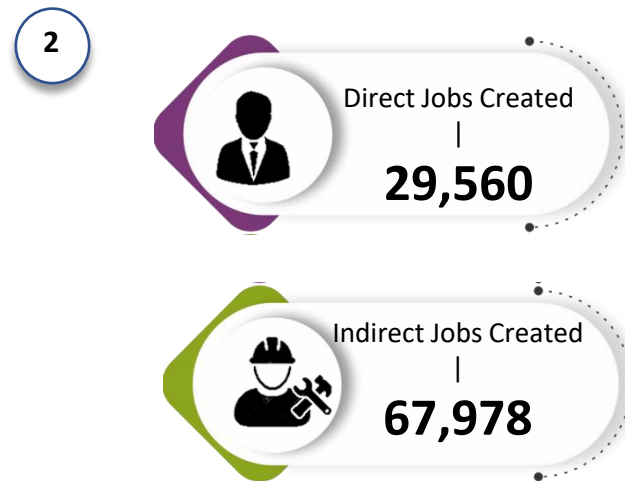
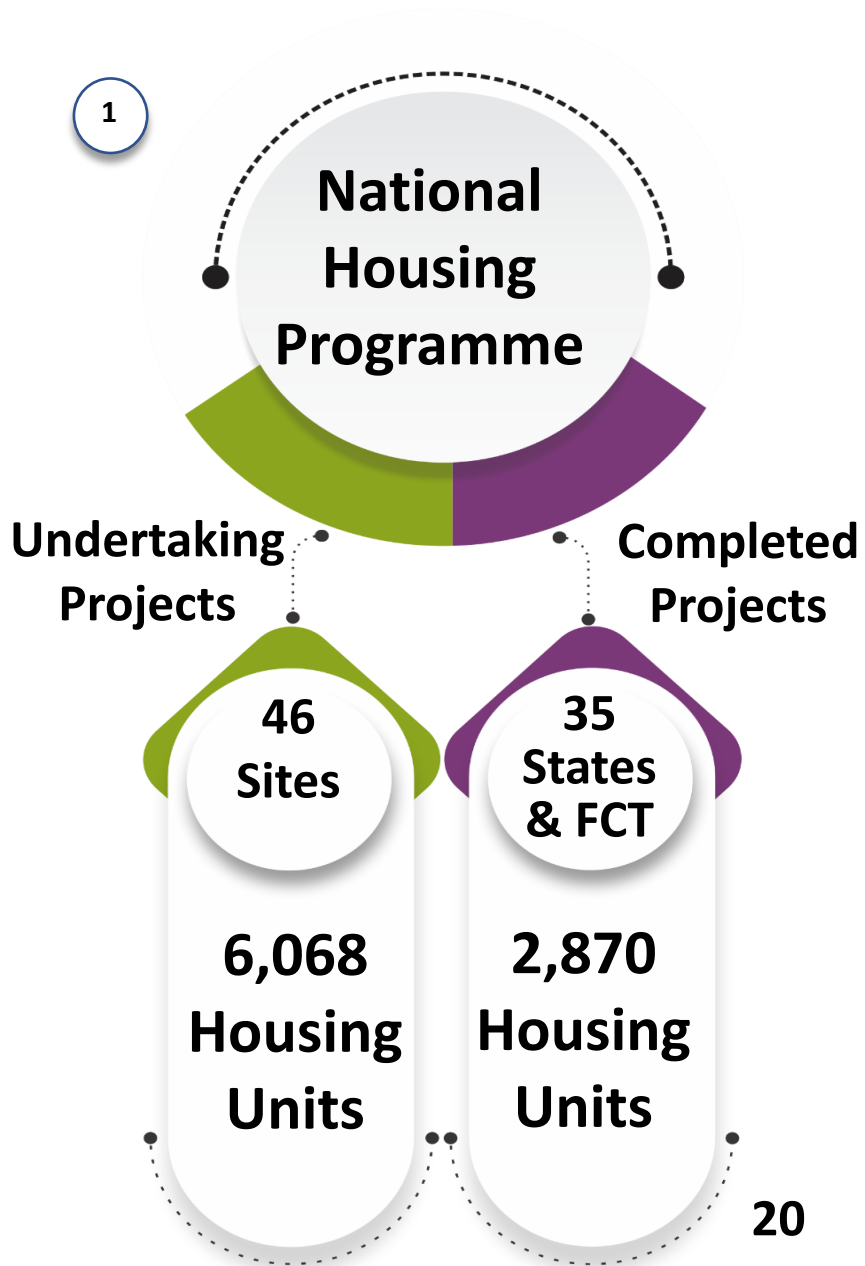

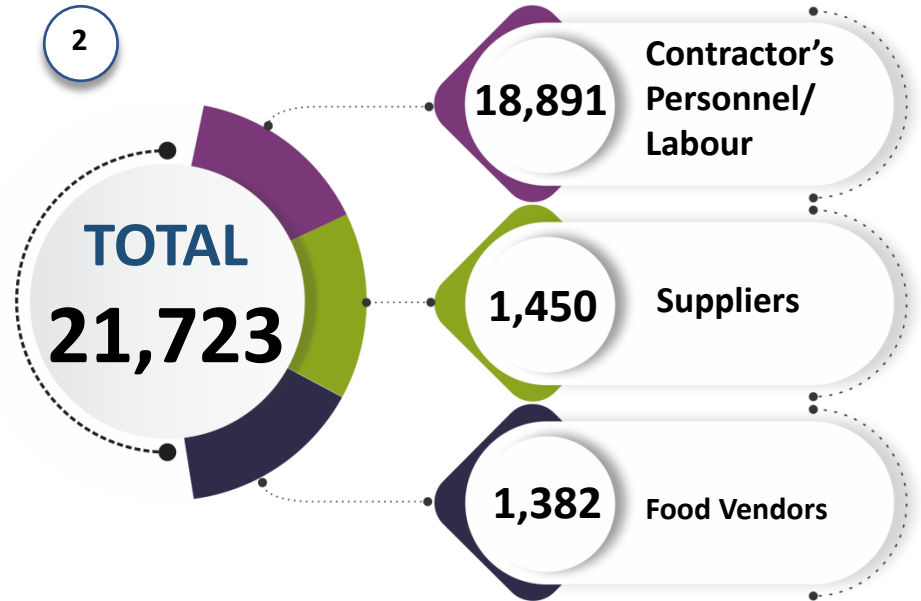

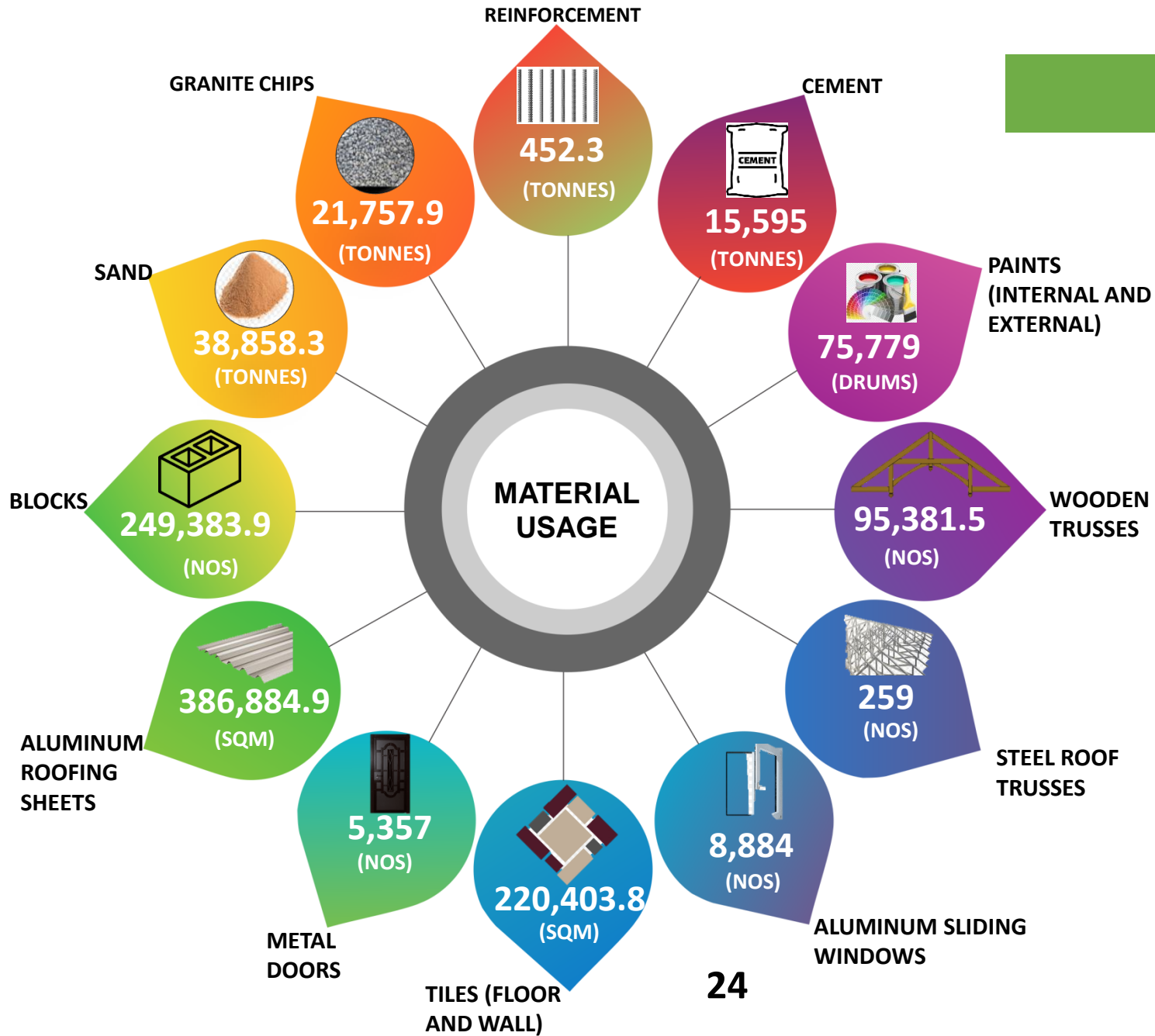

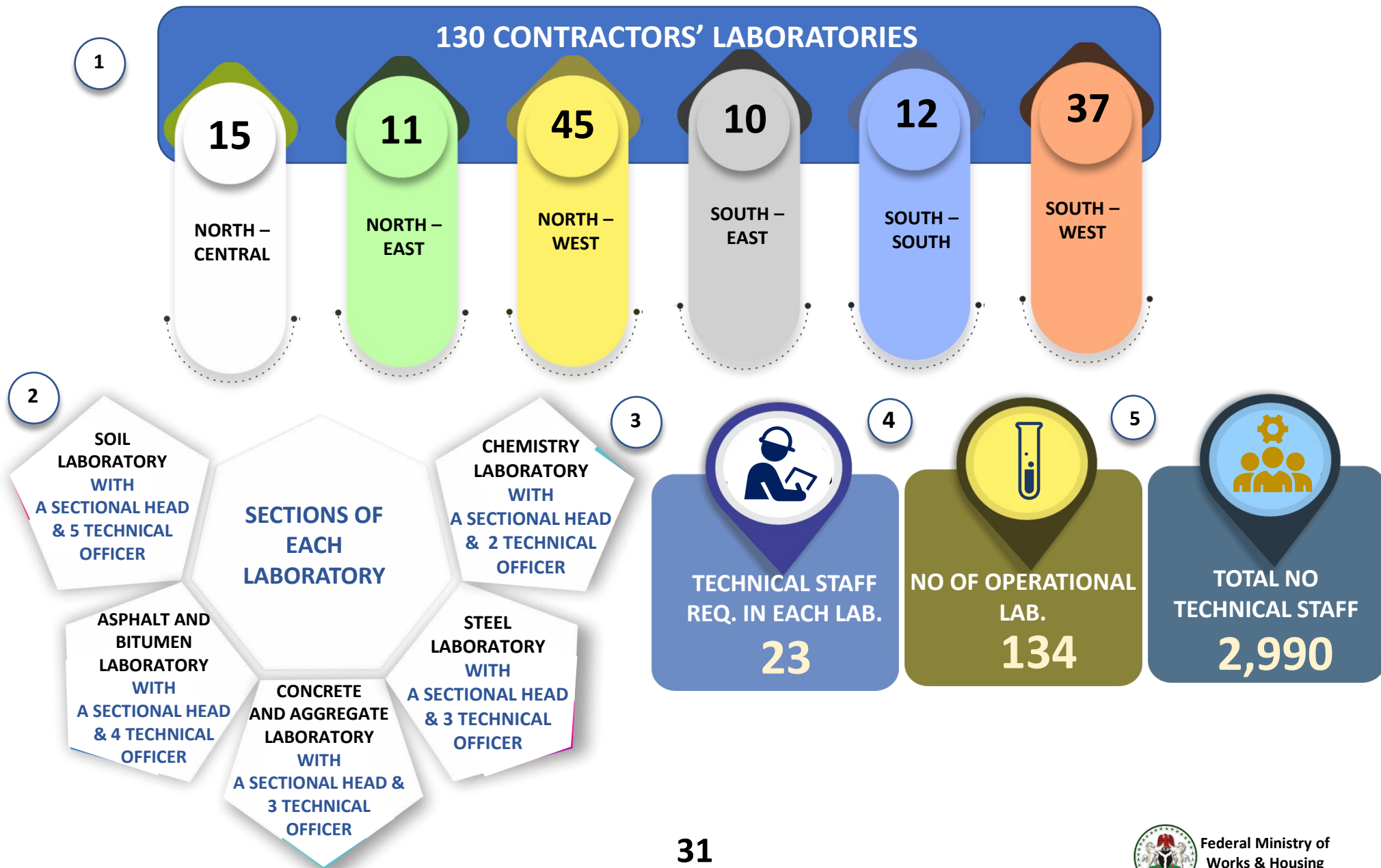
